

AISSAC - 2026
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Do I need to make payment for participating in AISSAC-2026?

Answer: **No.** There is no participation fees for e-counselling on AISSAC portal.

2. Do I have to report to any counselling centre for AISSAC-2026?

Ans: **No.** Actions by candidates pertaining to AISSAC-2026 can be done from a place of convenience (including from home) using a laptop/computer with an uninterrupted internet facility.

3. Do I require any documents to get registered online?

Answer: Since, it is an online allotment (Counselling) process, no documents are required during registration. However, you must produce documents at the time of Physical Verification at admitted school as per the details filled/verified by you during AISSEE/AISSAC-2026 registration.

4. I have filled incorrect domicile by mistake during AISSEE-2026 registration at NTA portal. Now, when I check result in AISSAC-2026 portal, it is showing incorrect domicile. How can I change it?

Answer: Change of domicile was allowed in AISSAC-2026 portal as per the window provided for changing personal particulars of the candidate.

5. I have filled incorrect category during AISSEE-2026 registration at NTA portal. Can I change it?

Answer: Change of category was allowed in AISSAC-2026 portal as per the window provided for changing personal particulars of the candidate.

6. I locked my choices/priority of Schools but now I would like to make further changes to my choice list. Is that allowed? If yes, how can I exercise the option?

Answer: If you wish to edit your choices and re-prioritise after locking **but before the choice filling deadline**, you can do so by clicking on the **EDIT CHOICES** on the portal. Post this deadline, no further changes would be allowed.

7. Choice filling deadline is already over. Am I allowed to make any changes in my choice list at this point?

Answer: **No.** You will not be allowed to edit your choice list after the deadline for choice filling, i.e., you cannot change the order of your choices **NOR** add any more schools **NOR** delete any school from the choice list after the deadline for choice filling.

8. I filled school choice list, but I forgot to lock them. Now the choice filling deadline is over, and I cannot make any further changes. Will this affect the list of choices that will be considered for allocating a seat to me during the AISSAC-2026?

Answer: If you do not lock your choices, default choices of the candidates will be locked automatically by the system upon reaching the deadline for choice filling. The automatically locked choice list will be considered for allocating a seat during AISSAC-2026.

9. When will the AISSAC online seat allotment process for this Academic Year start?

Answer: The Online seat allotment process will start as per the Schedule of the AISSAC-2026, promulgated on the AISSAC portal.

10. I got allocated a seat in a certain round of AISSAC-2026. I want to join the allocated school. What all steps do I need to follow?

Answer: If you want to join allocated school, first of all, you must click on **ACCEPT** button. After you accept the school, you need to carry out admission formalities within stipulated timeline by reporting physically as per the instructions of the school. Please refer to SOP for AISSAC-2026 for detailed guidelines.

11. I got allocated a seat in a certain round of AISSAC-2026 for the first time but I am NOT INTERESTED in this seat. I would like to wait for further rounds of AISSAC-2026 to possibly get other school. Do I need to do anything in the current round?

Answer: If you are allocated a seat in a certain round of AISSAC, and NOT INTERESTED in that seat, you need to follow steps mentioned below: -

- (a) Opt for **Reject** option in the seat allotment section to move to the next round. **Further, you will not be allowed to change the priority/choices of the Schools.**
- (b) Now you can participate in the next round of online counselling for the remaining available seats in your choice of schools. In doing so, the allotted seat shall be automatically cancelled and no further claim will be admissible for earlier allotted school.

12. Can I change my choice/priority of Schools after I opt for 'REJECT' option?

Answer: **No.** Choices and priority of Schools once filled & locked are treated as final and cannot be changed during any stage of counselling.

13. I was allocated a seat in one of the previous rounds and after I opted for 'REJECT', now I have been allocated another school as per preference in my choice list for this Round. Can I go back to the seat allotted to me in the previous round?

Answer: **No.** Once you are allocated a seat and you have opted for reject, your accepted seat from the earlier round will be automatically cancelled and your candidature would not be considered for previously allotted seat in subsequent rounds of counselling.

14. I was allocated a seat in one of the previous rounds and I had chosen ACCEPT option. Can I change my option to REJECT after acceptance?

Answer: There is no such option being provided to the candidates after seat is accepted by the candidates.

15. I have been allocated a seat in AISSAC for the first time. I have accepted the seat, but I have not yet paid my fees for an allocated seat. Will the allocated seat be confirmed to me by the school?

Answer: If you have been assessed FIT by the medical authorities, you need to report physically at the allotted school for document verification. Then, you need to pay the fees for confirmation of seat at allotted school. Please refer to SOP for AISSAC for more details.

16. What happens if I do not complete all the steps of reporting during a particular round of AISSAC in which I am allocated a seat for the first time?

Answer: Your allocated seat will be cancelled, and you will no longer be able to participate in the subsequent rounds of seat allocation process (if any) if you do not complete all the steps of Medical cum Physical Verification process including the payment of fee within the stipulated timeline. Please refer to SOP for AISSAC for more details.

17. I was allocated and confirmed a seat in a certain round. I am not interested in joining the allocated school. What should I do?

Answer: If you were allocated and confirmed the seat in a certain round and now, you are not interested in joining the allocated school then you must submit your unwillingness to the school through mail. Besides, if you do not report to allocated school before last date (as per timeline), it will be considered that you are not interested in joining the school and the allotted seat will be cancelled.

18. Is it necessary to change the category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST) of the candidate to the UR category during admission if the candidate gets allotted a UR category seat?

Answer: No, there is no need to change the category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST) of the candidate to the UR category during admission if the candidate gets allotted a UR category seat.

19. What can I do if there is a spelling discrepancy between the documents and the application form during Physical Documents verification?

Answer: If there is a discrepancy in spelling in documents, the candidate must carry an affidavit/undertaking to prove that the documents belong to the same person.

20. What is the procedure after completion of all online rounds if I have not been allotted any School?

Answer: In the event that seats remain vacant after completion of all six online rounds, an Offline Round shall be conducted, strictly subject to availability of vacancies.

21. Are there any SS Society authorised e-counselling cells/agents available for assisting/guiding the candidates/parents in this e-counselling process?

Answer: No. There are no authorised e-counselling cells/agents available. The candidates and his/her parents/legal guardians will have to read the SOP, understand, and fill the details in the e-Counselling portal themselves. SS Society or the Sainik Schools will not be responsible for any such unauthorised actions in this regard.

22. What is Offline Admission?

Answer: Offline Admission is a process wherein the unfilled vacant vacancies in Schools after the completion of all online rounds will be made available on the portal. It is a merit-based selection process and mere participation in the Offline Admission process/counselling is not a guarantee of seat allotment.

23. How do I choose for a School for Offline Admission?

Answer: The candidate's first preference school shall be treated as the default for offline counselling, unless removed during online counselling, in which case the next available preference shall be considered. If only one school was opted (or default choice considered due to inaction by candidate) and no valid preference remains thereafter, the candidate shall not be considered for offline counselling due to absence of a valid school choice.

24. I have not taken any action during my online rounds but have registered in the AISSAC portal. Will I still be eligible for Offline Admission?

Answer: **Yes.** You may be eligible only if you had already registered on the AISSAC portal as per timelines before commencement of online rounds, subject to un-utilised vacancies.

25. Can a candidate be represented by his parents/legal guardians or relatives on the Offline Admission Day of admission?

Answer: **No.** The candidate must be present physically. Only the parents or legal guardians (not exceeding two numbers) may accompany the candidate. No intermediaries/agents are permitted to participate.

26. Will there be any other round after Offline Admission?

Answer: **No.** There will be no additional rounds post Offline Admission Round.
